


-Public Use of Drones on the Museum grounds-



The Museum is located within a complex no-fly zone.

Any flight MUST be pre-approved by the Museum of Fire in writing 48 hours before the date of the flight. Individuals can apply for permission to fly a drone by emailing <u>ea@museumoffire.com.au</u> 7 days prior to the proposed flight date.

The Museum will only approve flights that meet the following CASA rules and retains the right to deny any flight request. If a flight request is denied the individual requesting the flight will receive a written response.

Approved flight must be:

- Under 120m/400ft above ground
- No closer than 30m from any person not involved in the flying
- One drone at a time
- Within visual line of sight
- Not over any populous area (where people are, or may be such as the train line when a train is underneath)
- Only during day time (10am 4pm)
- Have the necessary aviation licenses
- Abide by all CASA rules and regulations as outlined at casa.gov.au
